Develop a Cold Outreach Email Sequence

Use Chatgpt - <https://chatgpt.com/>

Prompt 1

My goal is to craft a cold outreach sequence that gets replies. To start, let's get the targeting right. I'm focused on the {job title, e.g., 'Head of HR at a UK-based finance firm'} and the key result I deliver for them is {describe the specific benefit, e.g., 'reducing employee onboarding time by 50%'}. Please use this information to create a single, powerful value proposition statement.

Prompt 2

With that value proposition as our foundation, let's map out the strategy for the sequence. Before writing any copy, please outline the logic for a 3-email follow-up. For each email, simply define its unique purpose, making sure each one builds logically on the last.

Prompt 3

Develop a Multi-Platform Content Calendar

Prompt 1

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Prompt 2

Prompt 3

Those ideas are approved. Now, please organize them into a simple content calendar for next week from Monday to Friday.

Assign the most impactful posts to the best days and platforms, and state the specific call-to-action that should be included with each post to support my business goal.

Generate Engaging Product Descriptions

Prompt 1

I need to write an engaging product description. My product is a {product name, e.g., 'Reusable Canvas Tote Bag'} and my target customer is an {customer profile, e.g., 'eco-conscious student in a UK city'}.

The product's top three features are {feature 1}, {feature 2}, and {feature 3}. Please first analyze this and translate each feature into a clear customer benefit.

Prompt 2

Using the features and their benefits, I need a creative strategy for the description. Please propose a "story angle" that would resonate with my target customer. Also, define a specific "tone of voice" for the copy using three descriptive adjectives, such as 'playful, practical, and positive'.

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Prompt 3

That creative strategy is approved. Now, write the complete product description using that story angle and tone of voice. Please structure the output with a compelling headline, a short narrative paragraph, and three bullet points that highlight the key customer benefits.

Generating Images with Consistent Branding

Prompt 1: Understanding Your Branding

I want to create a series of on-brand images using Gemini 2.5 Flash (Nano Banana). Before we create any prompts, let's first build a clear Brand Visual Identity Guide. (Please describe your brand's visual style using the following points):
